According to a recent report (<https://aub.ie/APPICreport>) by the Association of Psychology Postdoctoral and Internship Centers (APPIC), Auburn was one of only a handful of programs to have a 100% match rate between 2011-2023. This is well above the national average of 88% for clinical psychology PhD programs.
